Come and enjoy breakfast with your friends before school.

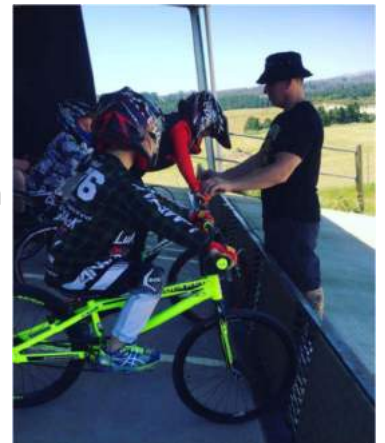




WHAT IS BMX?

BMX (Bicycle Moto Cross) is one of the fastest growing sports in Australia. It's a sport where the whole family can participate & riders of all ages (from 2 - 50+) can compete in organised race meetings throughout Australia. BMX racing ranges from club level to state level and right through to national and world championships events for all ages. BMX is also an elite Olympic sport!

Come along to the Ballarat Sebastopol Cycling Club BMX Division track on **Sunday May 6th at 10am**. You will receive an introduction to BMX & will get to experience some **FREE** on-track coaching which is being lead by former Pro-rider & 6 time national champion Tony Harvey. The club will also be holding a Fun Clubby afterwards starting at approx. 1pm.

Bike: **20inch** or **24inch** (Cruiser) BMX bike.
