Lots of fun has been had today with our JSC Pyjama day with special thanks to our JSC for organising a fun day for the students while raising funds for new play equipment.



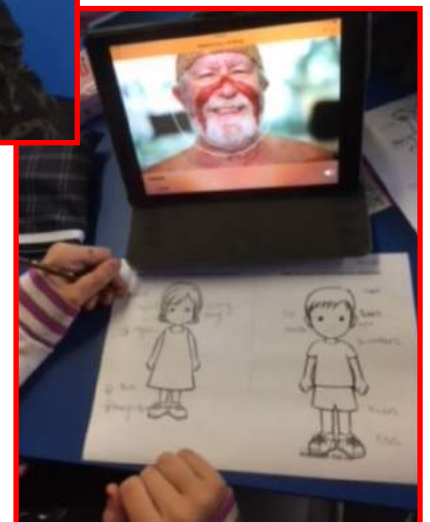
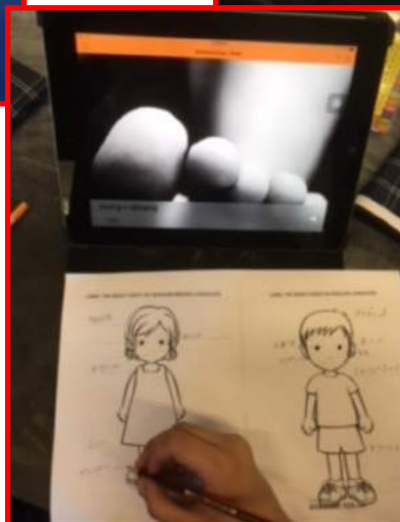
STOMP OUT THE GAP
