






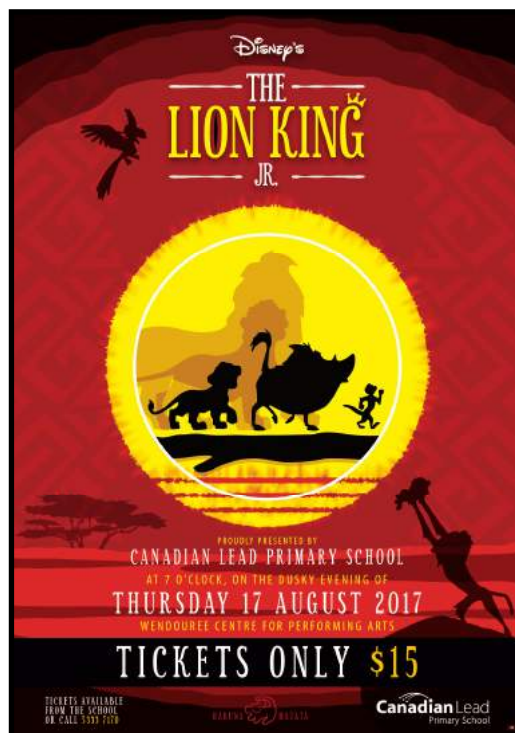

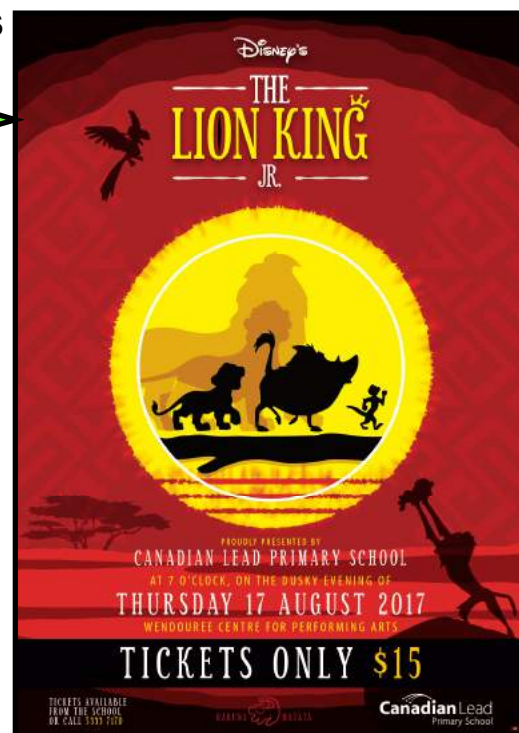
Canadian Lead Primary School Students proudly present

Parent Opinion Survey 2017

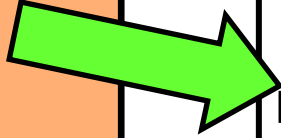

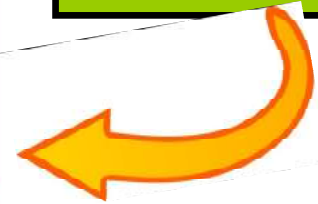

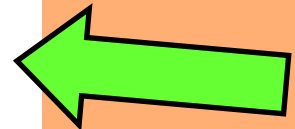
