If your child uses a Spacer with their Ventolin it is now a requirement by the Education Department and Asthma Foundation that each child have their own Spacer. We keep it at school in a container with their name on at all times and rinse between uses.

The Staff of Canadian Lead undertake refresher courses in Asthma Management and First Aid regularly to help keep your child safe at school.

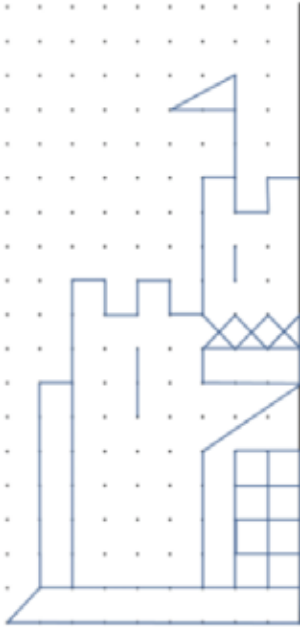

**Social Skills 11-11.45pm 12, 19, 26th Jan.**

Our program is based on evidence-based practice to help your child develop key social skills necessary for building friendships, relating to their peers and teachers, promoting successful classroom interactions and building confidence. \$40. per session.

**Control Your Emotions 1-1.45pm 12, 19, 26th Jan.**
