### EXCITING ANNOUNCEMENT for the Children of CLPS

Last Friday afternoon at 5pm, I was notified in writing by The Hon James Merlino, the Deputy Premier of Victoria and Minister for Education, that a playground application grant that I submitted on behalf of our school back in April of this year was successful and we have been awarded with \$193,700 to build a new playground project - the CLPS Inclusive play space.

I am absolutely thrilled about the outcome for our school and will be hearing from the Victorian School Building Authority this week to put together a more accurate timeline for the project. All works undertaken will meet both Departmental and legislative requirements (including the Disability Discrimination Act 1992). The Victorian School Building Authority will deliver this project for your school.

I would like to thank and acknowledge support from Maree Robertson as she kindly assisted me in researching the Principles of Universal Design in creating the plans for the project. I would also like to acknowledge parent, Deb Harris who kindly provided a supportive letter to accompany the application supporting our reasoning for a new playground. I will continue to communicate with families via our newsletter once I have more information about the timeline for the delivery of our new play space.

The Inclusive Schools Fund is designed to help make Victoria the Education State, providing Victorian government schools with quality new spaces and more inclusive facilities, based on best practice research and design.

# **NEW ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS**

*If your child is sick or absent, you are required to notify the school by 9.30am on the day of absence, by calling our School Office on 5333 7170 or by using our [School App—School Stream](#).*

*Notifying the school of your child's absence either prior to, or on the day that they will be away, helps ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and will fulfil your legal responsibility.*

*From the end of Term 2 2018, all Victorian government schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained.*

*This system also promotes daily school attendance. Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education, they learn new things every day – missing school puts them behind.*


# SCHOOLSTREAM

## WE ARE NOW USING A NEW SCHOOL APP - SCHOOL STREAM

To Access the School Stream app, go to the iTunes Store (iPhone/iPad) or Google Play (Android), search for **School Stream** and download the app to your phone.

Make sure you **allow push notifications** to get the most of the app.

When School Stream has finished installing, open the app, search for and select **Canadian Lead Primary School**.
