WE WANT OUR PARENTS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents think of our school. The Parent Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training that is conducted amongst a sample of randomly selected parents. It is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of parents' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour and student engagement. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies. Approximately 30 per cent of parents will be invited to participate in this year's survey. All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year the Parent Opinion Survey will be conducted from **Monday 22nd July to Sunday 11th August**.

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **10-15 minutes** to complete and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. These include: Arabic, Vietnamese, Mandarin, Chin (hakha), Hindi, Japanese, Somali, Turkish, Punjabi and Greek.

The survey results will be reported back to the school at the end of September. The survey results will also be communicated through our school council meeting later in the year. If you receive an email asking you to complete the survey, please make the time to do this as your views are important to us.

Dear Parent / Guardian,

The production is almost here! Please read the information below carefully to help us make the rehearsal and night run as smoothly as possible.

Dress Rehearsal: Wednesday 31st July 9:30 am

Food: As the performance is earlier than previous performances please ensure that your child/ren have eaten and may bring a snack and drink bottle on the night.

Tickets: Must be pre-purchased. A limited number will be available on the night.

We are asking parents to enter the auditorium through the main doors and fill the lower seating section, to allow students to use the upper section so they can enjoy some of the performance. If the lower section is completely filled we will take parents upstairs.

There is no allocated seating but ushers will ask parents to fill entire rows so we can fit as many students as we can in as well.

Costumes: Students' class costumes should be given to their classroom teacher and will be taken to the theatre for the evening performance by Friday 26th July. Any Main Cast, Senior Jitterbugs or Munchkin costumes should be brought to Mrs C in the music room by Friday 26th July.

End of Performance: To make it easier and less overwhelming for younger students in particular, parents will be asked to stay inside the auditorium until their children are in the foyer ready to be collected. Last time many younger students could not find their parents/guardians. While this means parents of older students might have to wait a few minutes, it will make the night much easier for younger students. Students must be collected from the foyer by a parent/guardian, they cannot walk outside or leave without you.
