

Home Reading

Teacher Responsibilities:

- deliver literacy curriculum at student point of need
- encourage student engagement in reading
- record home reading nights in the classroom and celebrate milestones

Student Responsibilities:

- bring home reading bag to school daily and change home reading book/s weekly (or as required)
- nightly reading as part of the homework policy

Parent/Carer Responsibilities:

- encourage your child to read every night
- talk with your child about what they are reading
- sign student diary

At Canadian Lead Primary School all teachers, students and parents/carers all play a role in the home reading partnership. This partnership aims to build students' confidence and understanding as life-long readers.

-All home reading nights, including holidays are counted, provided that a parent/carers has signed the students' diary.

-The use of home reading bags is recommended to protect home reading books.

-Home reading begins each year in Term 1, Week 3.
